



HISTORY OF TEMS

TEMS

Tredyffrin/Easttown Middle School is truly the home of learning. Students come as seeds and grow to become plants of unlimited knowledge. TE middle school is a kind and welcoming place to expand your brain, with amazing staff and principals. We all love being part of TEMS's community of great thinkers and learners, but how did this awesome school come to be?

Well, it all comes down to the school boards. The school boards of Eastown and Tredyffrin agreed to combine two existing high schools into one joint high school, to be known as Tredyffrin/Easttown Joint High School in 1907. This was clearly a big decision for the education system in our community. On the southwest corner of Conestoga and Howellville Roads, protected land was bought. (Don't try to do that; it costs far too much.) In 1908, the students at both high schools came together in their new learning home. Of course, students just kept coming and coming, until it was time

for the high school to expand, like all great schools do. A great thing happened in the year 1928. The size of Tredyffrin/Easttown Joint High School was doubled, allowing more thinkers to expand their brains. Many of which were athletic students, so athletic fields were laid around the school.

How does all of this relate to TEMS? Excellent

Speaking of which, in 1939 the junior high school had another improvement. The school boards made a significant change in the grade configuration (configuration is the arrangement of elements in a particular form, figure, or combination.) of their schools. Here's were it gets a bit confusing. "This was to change the program from the traditional 8 to 4



question. I'm sure by now you want to rush and find the answer to this question, but all of this connects to the building of our school. configurations: 8 grades in the elementary school and 4 in the high school, to one of a 6/3/3 program, in which there were 6 grades in the


elementary school, 3 in the junior high school, and 3 in the high school."

Now, the moment you've all been waiting for... the reveal! In a little bit. I'm sure if you've heard of Conestoga High School, your future school, if you don't move from the district. Conestoga was built in 1955, just two blocks away from T/E High School.

The TESD website states "When Conestoga opened, the Junior High School, which had been confined to one wing of the old high school building, moved into the entire building to become what was known as T/E Junior High. T/E Junior High School became an intermediate school in 1987, with the addition of students from the 6th grade. It was at this time that the 9th grade was sent to the high school."

You'll be happy to know that T/E Junior High School became what is know as T/E Middle School in 1992 with the 5th grade included. That's the end of these fascinating facts, of a truly fascinating school.
