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## ●●● MATH ●●●

**GAMES TO PLAY** (You will need a deck of cards with the face cards removed. Treat the ace as the number 1.)

- Multiplication War:** Deal out all the cards equally between 2 or 3 players. Each player turns over 2 cards and multiplies the numbers together. The person with the higher product wins the pile of cards. If you have the same product, then repeat the procedure. The winner takes all the cards.
- Close to 1000:** Deal 8 cards to each player. Use any 6 or your cards to make two 3-digit numbers. Try to get a sum that is close to or equal to 1000. Write these 2 numbers down. Your score is the difference between your number and 1000. Discard the 6 used cards and pick 6 new cards. Whoever has the lowest score after 5 rounds wins the game.
- The 24 Game:** Use The 24 Game for practicing math facts.

Sample playing card:

Make 24 using **all** four numbers one time only.

Use any of the four basic operations: +, -, x, ÷



Ex:  $4 + 2 = 6$

$3 + 1 = 4$

$4 \times 6 = 24$

### OTHER GAMES AND ACTIVITIES:

The Set Game, Sudoku, Connect Four, Legos, K'Nex, Yahtzee, Monopoly, etc.
