<p><u>1. Triple Words:</u> Write each word 3 times.</p>	<p><u>1. ABC Order:</u> Write words in ABC order.</p>	<p><u>1. Sentences:</u> Write 10 sentences using one spelling word in each sentence.</p>
<p><u>2. Rainbow Words:</u> Write each word in pencil. Then trace over each word three times using a different color each time.</p>	<p><u>2. Syllables:</u> Write each word. Next to each word write how many syllables are in the word.</p> <p><u>Example:</u> tiger - 2</p>	<p><u>2. Riddle:</u> Write a riddle or a clue to go with 10 of your spelling words.</p> <p><u>Example:</u> What letter of the alphabet can buzz? A <u>bee</u></p>
<p><u>3. Pyramid Words:</u> Write the first letter of the word on the first line. Then write the first two letters on the next line. Continue until the word is spelled.</p> <p><u>Example:</u> c ca cat</p>	<p><u>3. Add It Up:</u> Write each word. Then add up its value.</p> <p>Consonants = 5 Vowels = 10</p> <p><u>Example:</u> for = 20 store = 35</p>	<p><u>3. Letter:</u> Write a letter to a friend. Write at least 10 sentences using at least 10 of your spelling words.</p>
<p><u>4. Squiggly Words:</u> Write each word in pencil first. Then write the word again in squiggly letters.</p> <p><u>Example:</u> star</p>	<p><u>4. Words-in-Words:</u> Write each word. Then write at least two words you can make from each. You may scramble the letters to create new words.</p> <p><u>Example:</u> shower - show, owe, row</p>	<p><u>4. Story:</u> Write a story. Write at least 10 sentences using at least 10 of your spelling words.</p>
<p><u>5. Across and Down:</u> Write each word across and then down.</p> <p><u>Example:</u> when h e n</p>	<p><u>5. Rhyming:</u> Write each word. Then write a rhyming word next to each word.</p> <p><u>Example:</u> men - pen</p>	<p><u>5. Tongue Twisters:</u> Write 10 of your spelling words and write each one in a tongue twister sentence. (All words should start with the same letter.)</p> <p><u>Example:</u> Pink pigs <u>play</u> the piano.</p>
